Dr. Chalmers will share CMS’s strategic direction for advancing excellence in Medicaid program administration, and progress to date on increasing access to dental care among Medicaid, Medicare, and CHIP enrollees.

REGISTRATION:

The 2025 Symposium registration fee for state members is **\$685.00** per registrant on or before March 1, 2025. After March 1, the registration fee is **\$745.00** per registrant. All members must register via the MSDA website and pay in advance for the Symposium using the registration link on the MSDA website. 2025 GOALS:

The goals of the 2025 Annual Symposium are to build leadership and empower Medicaid, Medicare, and CHIP dental program administrators and stakeholders with knowledge; enhance public-private collaboration to improve oral health equity; and foster excellence in program administration.

CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS:

MSDA will offer up to 11 Continuing Education Credits (CEU's) for participants.

2025 SYMPOSIUM PROGRAM:

Engaging Partners to Foster Excellence in Medicaid Program Administration

MSDA's 2025 National Medicaid, Medicare and CHIP Oral Health Symposium will explore the role partners play in supporting state Medicaid Dental Program administration and complying with federal and state regulations. Topics include strategies for advancing oral health equity; expanding access to care; improving quality of data collection and systems; meeting reporting requirements for the Adult and Child Core Set of Health Care Quality Measures; advancing healthcare integration at the systems level; bolstering care coordination; and cultivating community partnerships. The Symposium agenda will also include the annual *DC Policy Update*, which will focus on updated priorities of the new Administration, and an *Evidence Update* on new clinical protocols, products and services that administrators should be aware of.

To be most effective in this charge, we are inviting all state Medicaid and CHIP dental program directors, managers and personnel, CMS, HRSA, IHS, NIH, and CDC federal partners, Medicaid vendors, providers, FQHCs, educators, researchers, economists, advocates, and other key stakeholders to attend. Our multidisciplinary approach is designed to enhance and support the integration of primary and oral healthcare systems across federal and state Medicaid, Medicare, and CHIP programs.

MSDA's Symposium provides an opportunity for collaboration and networking among Medicaid administrators, contractors, providers, advocates, and other stakeholders that impact health equity, healthcare equity, and costs associated with the oral healthcare delivery system.

TRAVEL AND LODGING SUPPORT:

Host Hotel and Lodging: MSDA has contracted with **The Alexandrian Hotel**. We have secured the *federal per diem rate of \$276/night*, plus tax for DC/VA area. Reservations must be secured with a major credit card. The credit card will not be charged.

All MSDA members seeking travel and lodging support from MSDA are *required* to reserve lodging at the Alexandrian Hotel in Old Town Alexandria, VA to qualify for travel support.

2025 Paid State Members: To help facilitate travel and offset registration costs, MSDA will provide travel/lodging support up to and not exceeding **\$1,200.00/pp**. Included in this rate are lodging expenses at the Alexandrian Hotel in Alexandria, VA for **May 4 and 5, 2025** for members who have paid 2025 membership dues by March 1, 2025. All members seeking lodging/travel support from MSDA are required to: 1) Register and pay for the

2025 Non-Paid State Members: For those state Medicaid dental program administrators whose States have NOT PAID 2025 Membership Dues by March 1, 2025, MSDA will provide a travel stipend of up to and not exceeding \$500.00. This may be applied to lodging at the Alexandrian Hotel, registration, and/or travel expenses.

Travel funding is limited and will be distributed on a first come, first serve basis. All members seeking travel support from MSDA are required to: 1) Register and pay for the Symposium on MSDA's website; and 2) reserve lodging at The Alexandrian Hotel, Alexandria VA to qualify for support.
